Welcome to A Dog's Life! Doggy Daycare and more...

A few things to remember for your dog's safety and well being....

- ❖ All daycare services are pre-paid. You may choose to purchase one of our discounted daycare packages, or you may pay-as-you-go AT CHECK IN TIME.
- ❖ First Day drop off is at **6:45 AM**. To maximize your dog's chances of having a stress-free first day it is important for you to be as calm and "boring" as possible at drop off time!
- ❖ Dogs must come into the daycare on a leash – if it's a flexi lead, please keep it locked.
- ❖ Dogs must have a quick release collar – this has a safety clasp, not a buckle. (No flea, metal, or choke collars of any kind are allowed in daycare)
- ❖ Dogs must have the following vaccinations completed prior to starting daycare:
 - Distemper (annual)
 - Parvo (annual)
 - Bordetella (minimum annual, recommend every 6 months)
 - Rabies (1st annual, every 3 years afterwards)
 - Fecal (within 6 months)
- ❖ Animal Control requires us to keep a copy of your dog's current Rabies Certificate on file. This is a legal document, signed by your vet. A copy of your receipt or your dog's rabies tag is not valid to meet this county requirement.
- ❖ All dogs are required to be on flea control continuously for attendance at daycare. It is your responsibility to keep your dog parasite free! Keeping your canine companion on an effective flea control program (available through your vet, not a grocery store product) virtually eliminates the risk of him/her picking up fleas anywhere-including your yard, the vet's office, the dog park, and doggy daycare.
- ❖ HALF DAYS are mornings **only** (7:00 – 11:30 am). Pick ups after 11:30 will be charged the full day rate.
- ❖ Dogs are to be picked up by 6:00 PM (exceptions for overnight care) – late fees may be charged at a rate of \$1.00 per minute.
- ❖ Please schedule your dog's visits in advance. There are days when we cannot accept walk-in dogs because the schedule is full.
- ❖ If your dog will not be attending on a scheduled day, please call us so other dogs can make a reservation. Chronically missed reservations will result in the loss of package days.

Things To Watch After Your Dog's First Day At Daycare

SORE PADS

Running amok may be rough on your dog's feet, and they may get sore and abraded pads. This will go away as their pads get thicker and used to running on different surfaces.

SORE MUSCLES

Your dog will be having so much fun playing at A Dogs Life!®, that they may forget to pace themselves and get sore muscles. Over time this will fade as you see them get stronger and in better physical shape.

EXHAUSTION

The new social interaction your dog will encounter while being at A Dogs Life!® will be both physically and mentally exhausting. Look for your dog to need a lot of rest when they get home.

"BOO-BOOS"

Dogs play with their mouths (teeth) and paws (toenails). You may notice scratches, scrapes, minute punctures or even small chunks of missing fur. These minor occurrences are normal and very common to group play.

WET COAT

Your dog's coat may be wet when you pick them up – rain is a common year-round event in our beautiful Pacific Northwest, and on hot summer days the dogs may have been lounging in one of our pools. Not to worry, they have free access to both inside & outside play areas.

ENTHUSIASM

Your dog's enthusiasm to enter the group will grow as they get more used to being at A Dogs Life!®. Eventually they will be just as excited to get to the daycare as they are when you pick them up at night.

HAPPY DOG

Their tail will be wagging and you may even see a smile on their face. It's their way of saying "THANKS" for bringing them to A Dogs Life!®.

I, the legal owner(s) and guardian(s) of _____ (hereinafter 'my pet'), hereby agree to the following terms and conditions of my pet's participation in activities at A Dog's Life! Doggy Daycare & more...

1. I understand that A Dog's Life! Doggy Daycare & more...and its employees (hereafter collectively 'The Center') agree to exercise due diligence and reasonable care, and to keep the premises sanitary and properly enclosed.

2. I understand that despite the best efforts of the staff at the Center, those accidents can occur. Pursuant to this agreement and in consideration of the due diligence exercised by the Center, I hold the Center harmless for any liability with respect to loss or damage resulting from disease, theft, fire, death, escape, or injury to my pet. I further hold the Center harmless for harm to any person, other pet(s) or property by my pet.

3. I agree that the Center may seek veterinary care for my pet if such care is reasonably deemed necessary for the welfare of my pet. The Center agrees that they will make all reasonable effort to contact both the Owner (or Agent) and the treating veterinarian before seeking treatment. However, I agree that if such contact is not successful that the Center may take reasonable steps to ensure the health and safety of my pet until such contact can be made.

4. I hereby certify that my pet is in good general health and is clear of any contagious diseases or conditions. I certify that my pet will remain current on all vaccinations as set forth in the Center's rules and guidelines. I understand that I must provide veterinary proof of such vaccination both before my pet's first visit at the Center, and periodically as required when vaccinations are updated (generally, every year). I also agree that my pet will be maintained on a scheduled monthly flea/tick preventative for attendance at daycare. I understand that any pet arriving at the Center with fleas and/or ticks may be treated (including a bath and/or application of flea control) as appropriate at the Center's discretion, and that I will be responsible for any such treatment if required. I hereby give the Center permission to request any relevant records from my pet's treating veterinarian.

5. I hereby certify that my pet is of sound mental health and of a reasonable disposition. I agree to abide by the judgment and expertise of the Center with respect to handling any potential temperament concerns. I understand that if I can or will not follow any recommendations that may be made by the Center with respect to my pet's training or socialization that my pet may not be allowed further visits to the Center.

6. I agree to pay the rate for services that are in effect on the date that my pet attends any activities at the Center. Prices are subject to change at any time without notice, and it is my responsibility to ensure that I understand the applicable rate for my pet and the activity in question. I also agree to the following terms:

- **All fees must be paid in advance (upon check-in)**, and no pet will be released until all charges are paid in full.
- Cancellation fees may be applied for reservations cancelled less than 24 hours prior to a scheduled reservation (see Center Rules)
- All pets will be released only to the Owner or the Owner's registered agent. It is the Owner's responsibility to approve any agent.

- All pets must be picked up by 6:00 p.m., and a late fee of \$1.00 per minute will be charged in accordance with the Center rules for late pick up. It is understood any pet left after 6:30 will be transported to our boarding facility and charged appropriate boarding fees as well as any incurred

late fees. The Owner will be responsible for all expenses relating to transportation, boarding and overnight care. Any pet left for over 24 hours without prior arrangement by the Owner or a registered agent will be considered abandoned, and the Center shall not be liable for the subsequent placement of the abandoned pet. By admitting my pet to activities at the Center, I grant the Center a lien on my pet for any and all unpaid charges resulting from services provided by, at, or through the Center, including but not limited to charges for boarding and placement/adoption.

- Pre-paid multiple-visit cards are non-refundable, unless we must request that your pet no longer attend the Center. Under these circumstances, you will receive a pro-rated reimbursement. All pre-paid multiple-visit cards will expire if not used for an entire 6 months.

I further agree that I shall remain liable for all charges incurred for the care and maintenance of my pet at all times.

7. I agree that the Center's liability for my pet shall under no circumstances exceed the lesser of the current tangible value of a pet of the same breed and general condition (age, health, etc.) or the sum of \$200 per animal. I further agree to remain solely responsible for any and all acts or behavior of my pet while in the care of the Center.

8. I agree that my pet may be photographed, videotaped, or otherwise recorded, and that such recording shall be considered the property of the Center and as such may be used by the Center in any form of advertisement, including but not limited to publication on the Center's website. I understand that the Center will not use the recording for any purpose other than promoting the business of the Center without my permission.

9. I understand that the Center reserves the right to refuse services or admittance to any dog for any reason.

I understand and agree to the above conditions.
